Dear Parent/Carer,

VISIT TO HARRY POTTER WORLD

With our trips to Harry Potter World fast approaching (and excitement levels rising!), I am writing to you to confirm details of dates and timings.

The first trip, on **May 20th** will be for **6JP, 6ILH** and **half of 6FL** (these children will be individually notified). The coach will be leaving at 7:30 a.m. so I would ask for children to arrive in school between 7:00 and 7:15 a.m. Please park in the loop, then walk your child to the front of school to avoid blocking the coaches. We will not be able to delay our departure, so please be punctual. We shall be returning between 8:30 and 9:00 p.m. incorporating a stop at the services for dinner. Again, please park in the loop. Children will need to bring a packed lunch and also money (no more than £10) for an evening meal. The money should be in a named envelope to be handed to the supervising adult on arrival at school. Children are to wear school uniform, but can wear trainers for comfort.

The second trip, on **May 21st** will be for **6AP, 6IB** and **the remainder of 6FL** (these children will be individually notified). The coach will be leaving at 7:30 a.m. so I would ask for children to arrive in school between 7:00 and 7:15 a.m. Please park in the loop, then walk your child to the front of school to avoid blocking the coaches. We will not be able to delay our departure, so please be punctual. We shall be returning between 8:30 and 9:00 p.m. incorporating a stop at the services for dinner. Again, please park in the loop. Children will need to bring a packed lunch and also money (no more than £10) for an evening meal. The money should be in a named envelope to be handed to the supervising adult on arrival at school. Children are to wear school uniform, but can wear trainers for comfort.

In keeping with similar attractions, merchandise is quite pricey, but we will offer the children an opportunity to visit the shop after our studio tour. We ask that children bring no more than £20 spending money for this purpose. This is their responsibility at all times.

We would like to give the children the opportunity to take photos of the Warner Brothers Studio tour so they can have memories to treasure. Children may bring their phone, or another camera to use for this purpose and accompanying adults will also have iPads to take photos on. Phones will not be allowed on the journey to the attraction and normal school policy will apply to mobile phone use. We reserve the right to remove the phone should any

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inappropriate behaviour occur. Should your child bring their phone, this also is their responsibility at all times.


Children are welcome to bring card games or small electronic games for the coach journey to help pass the time. Again, these are their responsibility.
