

KOINONIA could be translated as Community or Fellowship, but has a deeper meaning than this. Koinonia emphasises that we are all connected or linked together, - we are one, like the interdependence of the family where all are needed and valued and each person is important to the whole. We all support and encourage each other as we work together, each using their personal skills, to get the job done for the benefit of all. Everyone has a part to play no matter how small.
